Throughout the last year I have heard of several interactions that my son has had with his swim teammates as well as squadron members and roommates.
- 3. The only direct interaction I have had with C1C Hannigan is to say hello in passing at a swim meet.
- 4. The most telling description that my son has relayed about C1C Hannigan is that he is "one of the finest cadets at the Air Force Academy!" Last summer during Basic we had heard from about the various struggles, both physical and mental, that he was enduring as part of his introduction to the AFA. "Mikey" was one of the names of cadets on his swim team that he told us about, as he was very encouraging to all the freshman swimmers, continually reassuring them that they could make it through Basic and their swim team brothers were behind them. My son has used the following adjectives to describe C1C Hannigan "very kind", "fiercely loyal", "hardworking" & "passionate." has also stressed that C1C Hannigan did not hesitate to call put during swim practice if he felt he was loafing that C1C Hannigan took his captaincy seriously when leading by example to the swim team, while keeping in mind that C1C Hannigan was calling him out to help him be a better swimmer, not to ridicule or embarrass him.
